Gift Card Guidelines and Idea's

Listed below are gift cards that would be the most helpful to our families because of store/business location and types of items. We are still recommending a range of \$75-100 per individual because so many of our supporters ask, but please know that any quantity of gift cards will get to a family in need and make a difference.

Top 10 Cards for Families

- Target
- Walmart
- Kohls
- Major grocery stores with broad appeal and reasonable cost (Food4Less/Ralphs/Trader Joe's)
- Gas cards
- Visa/MC/Amex gift cards with a set value printed on the card
- Ulta or Sephora
- IKEA
- Movie passes
- Restaurant certificates for the whole family

Where to buy: Any major retailer that gives you an activation receipt is a good choice. Taping the activation receipt to the card is not required, but helpful for CCS staff and volunteers who will be tracking and checking values before giving to the families. Note: We recommend against buying gift cards online because of issues with fraud.

How to prep for Drop Off: The little envelopes for gift cards are not necessary, but if you do use them, please do not seal them because CCS has to log in the cards before we distribute. CCS will be placing gift cards in larger greeting card envelopes for distribution to families.

Cash or grant options: If you prefer that CCS staff handle purchase of gift cards, you may make a donation to CCS online or see below for donations by check.
